A band that will grab your attention from the first note, shake you upside down until you are flushed and dizzy, and then leave you wanting more...this band is one potent musical mixture!

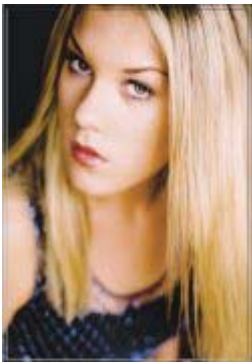

KAHUNA COWBOYS

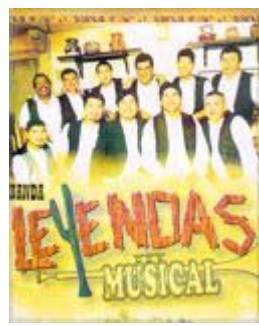
